BCS367 STONEBROOK BYLAW -6- GARBAGE

- (1) All garbage <u>must</u> be plastic bagged and tied before depositing in containers provided by the Strata Corporation for that purpose.
 (2) Any materials other than household refuse and garbage <u>must</u> be removed from strata plan *by, or at the expense of, individual resident.*
- (3) Garbage must not be stored outside of individual units. *This includes garbage cans, brooms, cleaning equipment, etc.*
- (4) All material designated as recyclable must be deposited in recycling bins. *Please flatten plastic cartons. No plastic bags or styrofoam!*
- (5) Smoking materials & cigarette butts <u>must</u> not be disposed of on common or limited property grounds. Failure of resident or their guests to comply with this bylaw may result in a maximum \$200 fine allowed by the Strata Corporation Bylaws being assessed against that owner.

NOTES:

- (1) Do not dump any garbage into recylce bins, as the City may refuse pickup and charge the strata more fees for special disposal.
- (2) Dump cleaned & stacked sytrofoam in corner of the mail room under the mailboxes so strata can have these sent to a recycle centre. *City of Burnaby does <u>not</u> pickup sytrofoam containers or packaging so your strata fees are used for a 3td party service to do this for you.*

Also use the United Boulevard Recycling and Waste Centre at 995 United Boulevard, Coquitlam. From Stonebrook, the drive along the Lougheed Highway is 10 minutes (5.3 km) to the east, whereas the Burnaby Eco-Centre on Still Creek is 13 minutes (9.4 km) to the west.
